# Why Health Care Price Transparency?

- Basic consumer protection issue
- Empowering consumers
- But will it reduce costs?



## Consumer-facing transparency

#### o Pros:

- Easy to understand
- Empowerment
- Some evidence of impact



### Cons:

- Most costly procedures not "shoppable"
- Information asymmetry

## Provider-facing transparency

#### o Pros:

- Doctor-patient relationship
- (Fairly) Clear evidence of price impact

### o Cons:

- Administratively difficult
- Provider resistance



## **Across-the-board transparency**

- o Pros:
  - Clear, makes sense to consumers
  - Levels playing field, competition
- Cons:
  - Never been tried
  - Massive provider resistance
